



#### Saskatchewan's Current Wait Time Impacts

The 90th percentile wait time was 246 days for MRIs performed in the first quarter of 2023-24 (April 2023 to June 2023). As indicated in the graph, this represents an increase of 26 days from Q4 2022-23. The overall MRI waitlist showed an increased by 627 patients from the previous quarter. Indicating that our growing population will require enhanced access to MRI services.

## St. Joseph's Hospital Estevan MRI Proposal – Project Objectives/Scope/Risks/ Next Steps:

#### **Project Objectives:**

The objective of this St. Joseph's Hospital Estevan MRI Project is to increase access to MRI services for patients in the South East and across the entire Province of Saskatchewan. This project aligns closely with the Saskatchewan Health Authority's Strategic Priority to provide seamless care as close to home as possible, and to improve health outcomes and to deliver improved patient flow in Saskatchewan. This Estevan MRI project will reduce patient and family transportation and transport for services. With the growing demand for MRI services over the past several years, this project will result in improved patient wait times for MRI services for all areas of the province by freeing up MRI appointment in other areas of the province.

#### Scope:

This St. Joseph's Hospital Estevan MRI project scope includes a 1.5T MRI system to be installed into a Modular MRI cassette building which will be attached to the St. Joseph's Hospital in Estevan. This project includes an additional modular building and renovation to the existing St. Joseph's Hospital which will allow for safety zones to ensure compliance with the requirements of Diagnostic Accreditation Programs safety guidelines.

## <u>St. Joseph's Hospital Estevan MRI Proposal – Project Risks</u> <u>Next Steps:</u>

Risks related to the management and balance of approved scope, budget, and timeline are present in all major infrastructure initiatives. When these risks are not managed, one of many consequences can emerge, including an inability to complete the approved scope within the timeline and/or budget.

Emmanuel Health will mitigate these risks by leveraging its established Imaging knowledge and relationships, project management processes (which includes strong processes for ensuring appropriate governance), approval structures for advancing projects through project gates (which are related to the staged release of funding), and formal issues management and change approval processes. Other risk mitigation will include:

- Development of detailed design and an independent quantity surveyor to confirm the construction projects cost estimates are within budget at the pre-tender stage;
- Ongoing consultation with user groups throughout the design phase;
- Contractual documentation is based on industry-accepted templates;
- Staff Recruitment of MRI technologists;
- Radiologist recruitment and College of Physician and Surgeons requirements for 50% on sight coverage for MRI services;
- MRI system and supply chain delays; and
- Construction cost escalations and delays.



- St. Joseph's Hospital Foundation Board of Directors Approve and Commit to fundraising \$6.5M to cover the Total Estevan MRI Project Costs (Total Capital Equipment, Total Building and Renovation Costs, and Total Staff Training and Staff start up expenditures); pending approval of the St. Joseph's Hospital Estevan MRI project proposal.
- St. Joseph's Hospital Foundation Board of Directors Approve and Commit to having the SJHF administrative team to develop and deploy a fundraising campaign to raise the full \$6.5M to cover the full cost of the St. Joseph's Hospital MRI Project. Any and all excessive funds raised would remain in an St. Joseph's Hospital Foundation's MRI Endorsement fund for future MRI upgrades, equipment, and staff training and incentives; pending approval of the St. Joseph's Hospital Estevan MRI project proposal.
